

WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR ----- 2019

Tasting Notes

Delicious aromas of dark cherry take the lead and are supported by notes of tobacco, leather, and baking spice. Balanced with moderate acid and food-friendly tannins, the flavors mirror the aromas with additional savory and herbaceous notes of black tea, cedar, and white pepper. The medium-long, tannin-driven finish is a perfect pair with classic dishes such as spaghetti and meatballs, grilled hamburger, or any kind of smoked meat.

Aroma I Cherry, pomegranate, tobacco, leather, baking spice

Mouthfeel I Medium-full body with food-friendly acid and tannin

Flavor I Cherry, black tea, cedar, and white pepper

Finish I Medium-long, carried by tannins
