



WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR 2019

Tasting Notes

Delicious aromas of dark cherry take the lead and are supported by notes of tobacco, leather, and baking spice. Balanced with moderate acid and food-friendly tannins, the flavors mirror the aromas with additional savory and herbaceous notes of black tea, cedar, and white pepper. The medium-long, tannin-driven finish is a perfect pair with classic dishes such as spaghetti and meatballs, grilled hamburger, or any kind of smoked meat.

Aroma | Cherry, pomegranate, tobacco, leather, baking spice

Mouthfeel | Medium-full body with food-friendly acid and tannin

Flavor | Cherry, black tea, cedar, and white pepper

Finish | Medium-long, carried by tannins
